At 1:16 p.m., J. Hai called the meeting to order, and welcomed Lt. Governor Driscoll. J. Hai expressed appreciation for the service of all members and shared her appreciation for the close partnership between Gov. Healey, Lt. Gov. Driscoll and the cities and towns of Massachusetts. Lt. Gov. Driscoll welcomed the members to the meeting. J. Hai then accepted a motion to adopt the minutes of the September 12, 2023 meeting, which was unanimously adopted. The Executive Committee then met (noted above).
