### Lowell Memorial Park, Cambridge Cultural Landscape Report & Update on Wall Repair

At this meeting, DCR will present an overview of the Cultural Landscape Report (CLR) for Lowell Memorial Park, located along Fresh Pond Parkway within DCR's Charles River Reservation. Staff will also provide an update on plans being developed for repair of the Park's historic brick and limestone walls. Public input will be solicited on DCR's management and preservation strategy for the Park moving forward, including implementation of the Cultural Landscape Report recommendations, potential partnership opportunities, and options for phasing the wall work, depending on the availability of funding.
