

DCR is steward to nearly 500,000 acres of public land, and it all began with the preservation of a landscape, the Waverley Oaks in Belmont in 1893.

### America's First Regional Park System

June 3, 1893 Metropolitan Park Commission established

#### First parks:

Beaver Brook Reservation (Waverley Oaks), Belmont

Stony Brook Reservation, Boston

Blue Hills Reservation, Milton

Middlesex Fells Reservation, Stoneham

1894 authorization to build parkways

1898 Lowell Memorial Park acquired as first segment of Fresh Pond Parkway

By 1903 MPC had acquired 9,246 acres





## Final Design - Highlights

#### Little Lowell

Wall Repairs with larger opening at Mt. Auburn Street

Reconfiguration of pathways for ADA access and to increase separation between cars and people

#### **Big Lowell**

Preservation of lawn areas and pruning of mature trees

Expanded pathway with ADA benches

Seating area and interpretive panel near Brattle Street entrance

Planting bed along Brattle Street to imitate shrub border of original design

Pedestrian lighting

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.25M



## LOWELL MEMORIAL PARK







- Leaves turn attractive shades of orange and red in fall.
- Fragrant, white flowers in clusters bloom in late spring; June
- Followed in fall by bright red fruits; persist throughout the winter
- Bracts emerge white with a green tinge, but mature to pink; April to May
- Purple-red fall foliage



Yellowwood

- Leaves open as yellowish green, turn bright green in summer and then turn yellow in fall
- Intensely fragrant, wisteria-like, pink flowers in large, drooping, terminal panicles cover a mature tree in late spring; May



 Fall color is an undistinguished pale green to pale yellow



#### Silver linden

PROPOSED TREES





- Clusters of small, pink to lavender flowers bloom along the stems in summer: June to August
- Flowers are followed by clusters of lilac-violet fruits; ripen in September through October.



Coralberry



- Golden yellow bloom
- Reddish-brown fruit that ripen in September and can persist well into winter.
- Dark green, lance-shaped leaves
- · Reddish, twiggy stems

- Bell-shaped, white flowers with a pink tinge appear in summer (June to July) along the stems
- Flowers give way to clusters of round, coralred berries which mature in autumn.
- Berries persist through most of the winter providing excellent color and interest to the winter landscape.

## LOWELL MEMORIAL PARK

PROPOSED SHRUB





- Herbaceous perennial
- Foliage is evergreen in mild winters, often turning reddish bronze in autumn and winter.
- Tiny, white or pink flowers with very long stamens in May



Common selfheal

- · Herbaceous perennial
- Dense spikes of purple to pink blooms from late spring to early fall
- Beneficial to pollinators





- Herbaceous perennial
- Small, fragrant, white flowers appear in spring; April to May







