

## General Information about LSP Board Fees

**What fees does the LSP Board impose, how much is charged for each fee, and what costs do these fees cover?**

Here are the fees the LSP Board imposes and some basic information about each one:

Fee Type	Amount	Notes:
<b>License Application Fee</b>	\$245 per application	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Fee is for written application only. If the Board approves the applicant's written application (experience, education, etc.), the applicant must also take and pass an exam to be licensed. Each applicant pays a separate Exam Fee each time s/he takes the exam. (See below)</li> <li>2. Application Fee is charged each time an application is filed.</li> <li>3. Fee covers the cost of processing each application.</li> </ol>
<b>Exam Fee</b>	\$325 per exam	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Fee is paid in advance of taking exam.</li> <li>2. If an applicant fails the exam, he or she may take the exam again but must pay another Exam Fee each time exam is re-taken.</li> <li>3. Fee covers the cost of developing, updating, and administering the Board's licensing exam.</li> </ol>
<b>Annual Fee</b>	\$225 annually	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Each Active and Inactive LSP is mailed an Annual Fee invoice once each fiscal year (July 1 through June 30). This invoice is usually mailed in January.</li> <li>2. Fee covers a portion of the Board's cost of running its disciplinary program.</li> <li>3. LSPs who are DEP employees, and therefore do not submit LSP Opinions, pay a reduced Annual Fee of \$60.</li> </ol>
<b>License Renewal Fee</b>	\$100 per renewal application	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. LSPs must renew their licenses every three years.</li> <li>2. LSPs are mailed a Renewal Fee invoice about 6 – 8 weeks prior to the date their licenses must be renewed.</li> <li>3. Fee covers the cost of processing each license renewal application.</li> <li>4. A Renewal Fee is also charged for processing an application for a 90-day extension.</li> </ol>
