XIII. ACCELERATED DEATH BENEFIT RIDERS 89

An accelerated death benefit rider allows the policyholder the option to accelerate a portion of a life insurance policy's death benefit. If an insured has been diagnosed with a terminal illness for a percentage of the policy's death benefit.

National 90

- Among all carriers marketing group long-term care insurance policies, three respondents report they offer an accelerated death benefit rider.
- Among all carriers marketing <u>individual</u> long-term care insurance policies, three respondents report they offer an accelerated death benefit rider.

Massachusetts

- Among all carriers marketing group long-term care insurance policies, three respondents report they offer an accelerated death benefit rider.
- Among all carriers marketing <u>individual</u> long-term care insurance policies, two respondents report they offer an accelerated death benefit rider.

One group carrier that completed the survey no longer markets its group products and does not appear in statistical data after calendar year 1999.

One carrier only offers an accelerated death benefit rider nationally.
