Lynn Liquors Mart, LLC (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 4, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Michael Teehan's Compliance Check Field Report.

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Michael Teehan.

FACTS

- 1. On, July 11, 2011 at approximately 6:55 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Lynn Liquors Mart, LLC.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a forty (40) ounce bottle of Natural Ice for two dollars and seventy five cents (\$2.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. Administrative review of the file indicates the licensee had a violation n 2006.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
