The Board of Registration in Pharmacy recently reviewed the above-referenced file and the activities leading to the voluntary surrender of your pharmacist registration (No. 22990/ Exp. 12/31/08) to the Board, pursuant to your letter to the Board dated and effective as of October 14, 2008. The Board is aware you have since entered into a contract with the Massachusetts Professional Recovery System (MPRS), effective December 2, 2008.

Please be advised the Board will consider a petition for reinstatement of your pharmacist license filed no sooner than December 2, 2009 (one year from the effective date of the MPRS Contract). Any such petition must include a recommendation from MPRS as to reinstatement of your pharmacist registration and any appropriate practice restrictions. Probationary conditions would be imposed by the Board for a five year period if your license is reinstated
