DECISION

4 EGGS HOSPITALITY GROUP LLC D/B/A LA GALLINA 1150 MARKET STREET LYNNFIELD, MA 01940 LICENSE # 07048-RS-0640 VIOLATION DATE: 3/31/2025 HEARD: 5/27/2025

4 Eggs Hospitality Group LLC d/b/a La Gallina ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, May 27, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators DiCicco & Wilichoski's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigators DiCicco & Wilichoski's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report;
- ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, Amendment Approved 4/7/2025, ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, New License Approved, 9/02/2022, Certificate of Organization for Kiwi Restaurant Group, LLC;
- 3. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On Monday, March 31, 2025, at approximately 6:42 p.m., Investigators DiCicco & Wilichoski ("Investigators") conducted a compliance check at 4 Eggs Hospitality Group LLC d/b/a La Gallina.
- 2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, was served an alcoholic beverage, one bottle of Estrella Galicia beer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since 2022.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. As a result, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
