DECISION

THE NEXT ONE INC. D/B/A ALCHEMY 1100 MARKET STREET LYNNFIELD, MA 01940 LICENSE # 06210-RS-0640 VIOLATION DATE: 3/31/2025

HEARD: 5/27/2025

The Next One Inc. d/b/a Alchemy ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, May 27, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators DiCicco & Wilichoski's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigators DiCicco & Wilichoski's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report;
- 2. ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, New License Approved, 7/13/2021;
- 3. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On Monday, March 31, 2025, at approximately 6:15 p.m., Investigators DiCicco & Wilichoski ("Investigators") conducted a compliance check at The Next One Inc. d/b/a Alchemy.
- 2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, was served an alcoholic beverage, one bottle of Bud Lite beer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since 2021.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. As a result, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
