What is a Member Advisory Committee?



- Advisory committee formed by the state Medicaid office after a formal selection process
- Consists of Medicaid beneficiaries with a wide range of Medicaid experiences
- Partners with Medicaid state agency staff to improve members' access to and experience with Medicaid
- Goal is to ultimately improve health care

MassHealth MAC Formation



- To improve quality and access to care for MassHealth members
- Desire to understand MassHealth member experiences with the program
- Address inequities
- Eliminate disparities in health and healthcare
- Core value of the agency

What are Brainstorming Sessions?



- Informal short-term meetings to guide development of the MAC
- Consists of diverse Massachusetts residents who expressed interest in getting involved with development of the MAC
- To engage Massachusetts communities in sharing their ideas for the development of the MAC based on their own unique life experiences

What are We Doing Together?



- About 5-6 meetings, 60-120 minutes through the months of April and May 2024
- Consists of respondents who expressed interest in creating and reviewing materials and who have lived experience related to MassHealth as well as facilitators from Collective Insight and MassHealth staff


