	The Medical Affiliates of Cape Cod, Inc. ("MACC") is a non-profit affiliate of Cape Cod Healthcare,
	Inc. ("CCHC") that employs many of the system's affiliated physicians. CCHC is an integrated
	healthcare delivery system which includes Cape Cod Hospital, Falmouth Hospital and other health care
	providers located on Cape Cod. MACC is governed by a board of trustees that mirrors CCHC's own
	board of trustees as well as a physician advisory board.

14.	4. Briefly describe the nature and objectives of the proposed material change:					
	MACC has entered into a Stock Purchase Agreement with Emerald Physician Services Inc. ("Emerald"), a group practice of 15 physicians that has 11 offices on Cape Cod. The agreement calls for MACC or its designee to purchase 100% of Emerald's outstanding capital stock. Emerald would essentially become a wholly owned subsidiary of MACC					
	Upon consummation of the contemplated transaction, Dr. Cormac F. Coyle, the current sole owner of Emerald, would continue to lead Emerald's physician practice operations. Dr. Coyle would also provide advice to the MACC as to practice models and other matters proven within Emerald to improve the quality of care provided as well as overall patient satisfaction. Currently, MACC operates at a loss. This is due in part to practice inefficiencies and high labor costs.					
	Notwithstanding its location on Cape Cod, Emerald has excelled in providing quality care at a lower cost, thereby earning a profit. Emerald consistently receives high quality rankings and has succeeded in reducing waiting times to provide timely patient access for initial and follow-up appointments. Emerald also has achieved success in participating in innovative program models, including federal demonstration and incentive programs. In particular, Emerald:					
	 receives the highest quality rankings in its payer contracting group for all major payer measures; 					
	 guarantees same day acute or urgent care appointments, provides Saturday hours and employs an iPhone app as one method of easing patient/family communications with providers; 					
	 reduces unnecessary re-admissions through its post-hospital discharge clinic, and provides home care visits especially to elderly patients; 					
	 provides advocacy services for patients with social, economic, legal and behavioral needs; 					
	 provides medical education programs for physicians and advanced practice training for nurses; 					
	was selected as reader's choice award winner for internal medicine for the last twelve years in a row, and was					
	 recognized as one of the top employers in the Commonwealth; and has received the maximum incentive payments for meaningful use of electronic health records, among other innovative programs. 					
	MACC intends to apply Emerald's practice management model to MACC's existing operations. MACC 's objective is to reduce its cost of delivering care by adopting Emerald's more efficient methods and practice models, while at the same time improving patient access and quality of care.					
15.	Briefly describe the anticipated impact of the proposed material change:					
	The proposed transaction is expected to lower the cost of care delivered by the MACC's providers, to improve patient					
	access and satisfaction, and to raise the quality of care delivered to Cape Cod residents and visitors.					
	The proposed transaction is not expected to disrupt established patient care patterns because there are no anticipated					
	changes in MACC's or Emerald's practice locations, and there are no anticipated changes to hospital referrals by Emerald'					
	physicians.					
	Emerald's physicians will become members of the Cape Cod Preferred Physicians (the "PO"), which participates in					
	contracting done through the Steward Health Care Network ("Steward"). Steward contracts on behalf of approximately					
	7,000 physicians who practice throughout Eastern Massachusetts. MACC does not anticipate that participating in these					
	contracts will result in increased reimbursement for Emerald physicians compared with their present payment rates. In					
	recent past years Emerald has participated in contracts negotiated through the Beth Israel Deaconess Physician					
	Organization.
