**AAPTA LLC D/B/A ONE STOP MART

AAPTA LLC d/b/a One Stop Mart (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, January 23, 2018, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Lordan's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Lordan's Compliance Check Field Report; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.
 - A. Photographs of Signage inside Licensed Premises;
 - B. TIPS Certifications; and
 - C. Licensee's Change of Manager Application.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.


FACTS

1. On Wednesday, August 16, 2017, at approximately 5:49 p.m., Investigators Di Cicco and Lordan ("Investigators") investigated the business AAPTA LLC d/b/a One Stop Mart.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a Miller Light beer, for two dollars and seventy-five cents (\$2.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.


CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for two (2) days which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
