**DECISION**

**MALDEN & MELROSE LIQUOR MART INC. D/B/A M & M LIQUORS  
619 BROADWAY

Malden & Melrose Liquor Mart Inc. d/b/a M & M Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, January 16, 2018, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Lordan's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Lordan's Compliance Check Field Report; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

**FACTS**


1. On Wednesday, August 16, 2017, at approximately 5:07 p.m., Investigators Di Cicco and Lordan ("Investigators") investigated the business Malden & Melrose Liquor Mart Inc. d/b/a M & M Liquors.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 6-pack of Bud Light beer, for seven dollars and twenty-five cents (\$7.25). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

### CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has had no prior violations in over 20 years, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
