Overview

Consistent with the policy announced in May 2023 in [All Provider Bulletin 366](#), updated in [All Provider Bulletin 390](#), [All Provider Bulletin 400](#), and [All Provider Bulletin 407](#), as well as the requirements in M.G.L. c. 118E, § 13L, [130 CMR 405.000](#): *Community Health Center Services*, [130 CMR 406.000](#): *Pharmacy Services*, and [130 CMR 410.000](#): *Outpatient Hospital Services*, MassHealth will not pay for certain high-cost drugs if purchased through the 340B Drug Pricing Program. In accordance with Section 2.7.B.5 of the ACPP and MCO contracts, MassHealth is directing the Managed Care Entities identified above to do the same.

This bulletin applies to Accountable Care Partnership Plans (ACPPs) and Managed Care Organizations (MCOs).

Summary

Effective August 18, 2025, ACPPs and MCOs are required to mirror the payment policies described in [All Provider Bulletin 407](#) for acquisition of drugs listed in that bulletin. ACPPs and MCOs must also continue mirroring the payment policies described in [All Provider Bulletin 390](#). See [MCE Bulletin 114](#).

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
