PIZZA BOXES - can be recycled, heavily soiled part cannot.

Water based paint, dry out and put with curbside trash. Oil paint is HHW.



One-Use disposable bag. DO NOT recycle in cart. Return to grocery store.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE WASTE YOU GENERATE!

On June 10, 2014, City Administrators and Municipal Council passed an Ordinance to add monetary penalties to enforce the MANDATORY RECYCLING Bylaw, established in 1993.

In 1990, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) introduced its first bans on landfilling, combustion of easy-to-recycle and toxic materials. MassDEP Waste Ban Regulations: 310MR 19.017

Prohibited in Trash: recyclable materials, glass, plastic containers, paper, cardboard, leaf and yard waste, asphalt pavement, brick, concrete, clean gypsum wallboard, wood and metal.

City of Amesbury MANDATORY RECYCLING with RECYCLING ENFORCEMENT, VIOLATIONS & PENALTIES BILL No. 2014-067 - establishes penalties for waste generators in the City who do not recycle, as follows: First Offense - Written Warning to the owner on record. Second Offense - Fine of \$100.00. Third Offense - Fine of \$250.00. Fourth Offense - Fine of \$500.00 and a Criminal Complaint., passed June 10, 2014.

Waste Reduction and Recycling Agents for the City through the Department of Public Works, will be on the streets educating and assisting RESIDENTS, PROPERTY AND BUSINESS OWNERS, alike, about MANDATORY RECYCLING. Enforcement will officially begin January 1, 2015. The City Administrators' and Municipal Council's intent is "to encourage reuse and/or recycling of certain waste materials, conserve disposal capacity and reduce adverse environmental impacts from waste materials containing toxic substances" (MassDEP Fact Sheet - Your Municipality and Waste Ban Compliance, 2014).
