Recycling is now much easier!

You no longer have to separate paper & cardboard from glass, plastics and metal. Instead, you may mix all recyclable materials together in one or more containers for collection at your curb.

Recycling is also mandatory

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts regulations prohibits the disposal of recyclables including paper, cardboard, bottles, plastics and cans with household trash. Additionally, the City of Haverhill Board of Health regulations require recycling.

RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING LITTER, GARBAGE, AND REFUSE

Section 5: Residential dwelling units

I. Residents shall separate their recyclable materials for bi-weekly curbside collection. Residents can place their recyclables out for collection in open containers, boxes, or paper bags clearly marked recycling.

Section 10: Penalties

A. Any person(s) who fails to comply with this regulation shall be fined not less than fifty (\$50.00) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for each offense. Each day's failure to comply with this regulation shall constitute a separate offense.

YOU CAN RECYCLE AS MUCH AS YOU WANT — THERE IS NO LIMIT! However, there is a limit on trash disposal. Each residential unit shall not exceed three (3) thirty five (35) gallon trash bags/containers. Please do not purchase any barrel larger than 35 gallons. OSHA rules do not allow our trash hauler to pick up any barrel larger than 35 gals. or heavier than 50 lbs.

Is this program mandatory?

Yes, Massachusetts prohibits the disposal of recyclables including paper, bottles, plastics and cans with household trash.

Do I need to clean items before putting them in my bin?

Your recyclables should be rinsed and clean of any food. Items with food residue or grease cannot be recycled because of contamination.

Why aren't plastic bags accepted at curbside?

The materials recovery facility uses an automated system to sort and package the recyclables. Some items, such as plastic bags, will jam the machinery. However, plastic bags of all types can be recycled at most supermarkets, in a container often located near the entry/exit. Reusable tote bags are a great way to avoid plastic bags entirely.

Will the Recycling Center remain open?

Yes, The Haverhill Recycling Center at 500 Primrose Street accepts single-stream recyclables Wed. and Sat., 8AM - 1PM. Tires, scrap metal and appliances are accepted for a fee. Other items, such as yard waste, electronics, fluorescent light bulbs, some batteries and used motor oil are accepted at certain times. Please call for details.

What is the city doing to improve participation? Through the Sustainable Materials Recovery Program, a grant given to selected

municipalities to help increase recycling participation, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection assisted the city in hiring two Mandatory Recycling Enforcement Coordinators—Franco Cordano and Karin Devlin of Haverhill. Within the goal of increasing participation and tonnage collected, their responsibilities include educating the community about the benefits of recycling, as well as tracking actual participation rates. Their initial research, conducted during Fall 2011 using GPS tablet technology, showed that 58% of Haverhill's households were participating in single-stream curbside recycling. While this is a great start, it leaves much room for improvement. Such improved participation would significantly reduce the amount the city must pay for trash disposal.

Throughout 2012, the recycling coordinators will be visiting neighborhoods to monitor recycling and distribute educational materials. Information will also be posted on the City's website and public access channels. To ensure compliance with the state and local recycling regulations, warning notices will be sent to those residents who are not recycling. Eventually, failure to comply with these regulations may result in a fine of \$50.00 being issued to the property owner.

Recycle more, trash less

When you recycle more, you'll have less trash and won't need as many trash cans. Convert one of your trash cans into a recycling container by labeling it with the Haverhill Recycles sticker. Recycling stickers are available at Haverhill City Hall and the Haverhill Recycling Center at 500 Primrose Street.

No sticker? No problem. Just clearly mark the outside of your container so it can easily be identified as a recycling container. You may also continue to use your small green bin.

Most households will find it helpful to keep a smaller recycling container handy in or near the kitchen for daily use, then empty that bin into the larger, outdoor recycling container as needed. Then simply place your container(s) at the curb for collection every other week, according to your street's scheduled assignment.

Remember, unlike trash, there is no limit to how much recycling material you can place at the curb for collection. Provided that each container is no larger than 35 gallons, you can place as many containers at the curb as you wish.
