### **OBSERVATION REPORT #7**

Flow through documentation is not publicly or readily available to CLECs.

# **Issue 7.1**

KPMG has been unable to locate a flow through document that defines which USOC codes are flow through or non-flow through for Bell Atlantic – North.

## **Assessment**

This practice may be a concern for the following reasons:

- An official document that defines which USOC codes are flow through or non-flow through would be useful to CLECs to increase the flow through rate and decrease the reject rate for UNE-P and Resale orders. These documents would give CLECs better information about when to expect Local Service Confirmations (LSCs). However, these documents are not made readily available to the CLECs.

### **Issue 7.2**

The Bell Atlantic- North Generic Ordering Flow Through Scenarios document located on Bell Atlantic's TISOC web-site does not appear to be current and comprehensive.

### Assessment

The Bell Atlantic North Generic Ordering Flow Through Scenarios located at <a href="http://www.bell-atl.com/tis/sup/Except Resp 40 Final.pdf">http://www.bell-atl.com/tis/sup/Except Resp 40 Final.pdf</a> does not appear to be current and comprehensive, despite the fact that Bell Atlantic has stated on the TISOC site that this document is updated periodically.
