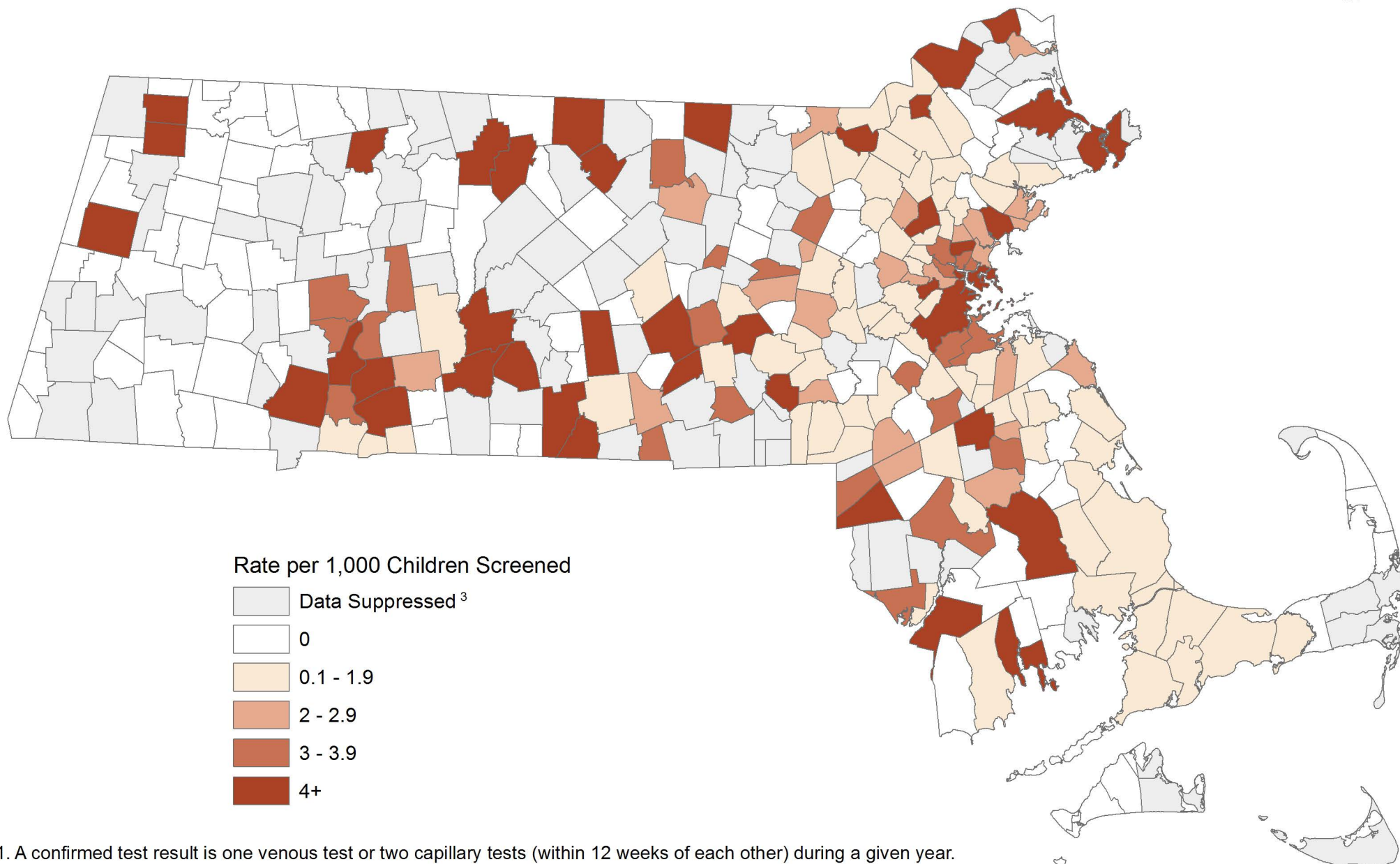
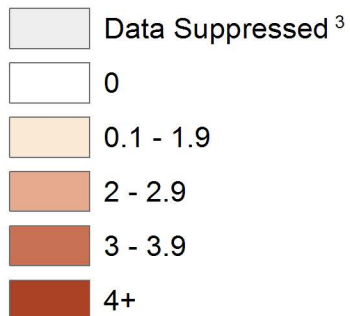

1. A confirmed test result is one venous test or two capillary tests (within 12 weeks of each other) during a given year.
2. Blood lead levels $\geq 10 \mu\text{g}/\text{dL}$ are poisoned.
3. Data is suppressed if the aggregated numerator count is between 1-5 and the aggregated denominator count is $< 1,200$. These small numbers are suppressed to protect privacy.
