Night Work, I-90 Eastbound
March 22, 2026 to May 1, 2026

BOSTON - The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is advising the public of upcoming night work adjacent to I-90 Eastbound at Bowker Overpass. This work will be performed nightly from 9 p.m. through 5 a.m. Work will include concrete removal at the existing bridge piers in preparation for concrete rehabilitation work. This work is part of the Bowker Overpass Bridge Replacement Project.

What to Expect:

- Night work will begin nightly at 9 p.m. and be completed by 5 a.m.
- Work shifts will be Sunday night through Thursday night each week.
- Work will occur adjacent to I-90 Eastbound along the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) Commuter Rail at Bowker Overpass.
- During this night work, construction noise levels will continue to be monitored throughout work activities and in compliance with all requirements and ordinances.

This work is being conducted as part of an \$84 million project to replace the Bowker Overpass Bridge over I-90/Ipswich Street/MBTA Commuter Rail.
