Eligible entities are community-based culturally specific programs that are led by and created for the primary purpose of providing culturally specific services to one or more communities of color in Western Massachusetts (specifically Berkshire, Franklin, Hampden, and Hampshire Counties). Culturally specific programs must have an organizational mission primarily focused on one or more communities of color.
