

MINUTES

March 31, 2025

A Hybrid Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on March 31, 2025. In participation was: Supt. Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Superintendent Barton Morris, Entomologist Aubrey Paolino, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, and Commissioners James Quirk and Emily Beebe.

The following remote meeting declaration was read into the minutes:

Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project Board of Commissioners is meeting remotely pursuant to legislative authorization extending the remote meeting provisions of the Open Meeting Law through 3/31/25, as signed into law by Governor Healey on March 29, 2023.

Commissioner Quirk made a motion to approve the minutes of February 24, 2025. Vice-Chairman Collins 2nd the motion and it passed unanimously by way of roll call with Commissioner Beebe abstaining due to being absent from that meeting.

Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to nominate Commissioner Quirk the Secretary of the Board. Commissioner Beebe 2nd the motion and it passed unanimously by way of roll call.


Supt. Sakolsky updated the Board on the FY25 budget status. She explained the Project's actual account funding process, the State Reclamation Board (SRB) loan repayment structure the Project was working through, and informed that FY25 COLAs with retro pay had been processed and completed. She also informed that merit increases would likely be considered for processing when the loan is repaid in full.

Crews have been kept busy with their water management routes as well as calls for service. Change over to larvicide operations will take place mid-April as there is already larvae being detected in some areas including Cape Cod National Seashore (CCNS) property. CCMCP did receive a permit for larvicide treatment from CCNS effective April 1, 2025.

The Board was reminded of their expectation to complete the annual mandatory online training.

The next meeting was scheduled for April 28, 2025 at 2PM.

There being no further business, Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Commissioner Beebe and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
