FOOTNOTE:

R7.4.1.4 Decisions and discipline of certification holders. The BOCC shall issue a written decision after the hearing. Decisions shall be issued in a reasonably prompt manner. **The decision of the BOCC shall serve as a recommendation to the BBRS and shall be promptly forwarded by the Administrator to the full board for review.** If after a hearing the BOCC finds that the holder has violated any provision of R7.4.1.5, it may recommend suspension of a certification for a fixed period of time, revocation of a certification permanently, or a reprimand of the certification holder. Further, the BOCC may recommend that any order include appropriate remedial or disciplinary conditions. Once forwarded to the BBRS, the board shall either, adopt the recommendation in its entirety, adopt the recommendation with amendment, reject the recommendation in its entirety, or remand the matter to the BOCC further proceedings. A certificate holder whose certification is revoked may apply in writing to the Board for reinstatement no sooner than one year from the date of the revocation.

Additional Business:

Correspondence from Mr. Craig Shibley regarding George Ricker's, Town of Barre, extension.

March 6, 2013 - Mr. Ricker's file was reviewed for any discrepancies or inaccuracies made in the correspondence. One discrepancy was found in the letter dated October 9, 2012. The letter stated Mr. Ricker was appointed prior to the R7.1.4.6.1 change in no conditional appointee shall be afforded more than three extensions. Which went into effect January 1, 2088. Mr. Ricker was appointed August 8, 2008 and therefore, should not have been factored into the decision to approve Mr. Ricker for another extension. Given that Mr. Ricker's extension is due to expire March 31, 2013 the BOCC made the determination no action will be taken at this time. A letter will be sent to Mr. Ricker after March 31, 2013 if correspondence is not received regarding an extension.

February 6, 2013 - Mr. Shibley was present at BOCC meeting and was invited by Chairman Don Torrico to speak to Committee Members. George Ricker's file will be reviewed and any discrepancies or inaccuracies made in the correspondence will be addressed and reviewed at the March 6, 2013 meeting.

2/6/2013 - Letter received January 24, 2013 from Mr. Shibley. This review is to specifically address 'Mr. Ricker's official file contains no documents of him being appointed in 2006 as claimed by the BOCC on no few than two occasions.' Mr. Shibley is requesting documents confirming his (George Ricker) appointment as I of B for the Town of Barre on or around October 10, 2006.

George Ricker submitted an Examination Approval Form along with his resume to be reviewed by the BOCC for approval to take the Inspector of Building exams. The BOCC approved George Ricker's qualifications on October 10, 2006. I am thinking Mr. Shibley is referring to the New Employee Report Form received August 14, 2009 informing this office he was appointed August 8, 2008. At the bottom of the form, under FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY, 'Date Qualifications Accepted: 10/10/2006 I of B. This is the only reference to the date October 10, 2006 in George Ricker's file.

Therefore, Mr. Ricker's Examination Approval Form and resume were reviewed by the BOCC on October 10, 2006 to proceed with the Inspector of Buildings / Building Commissioner exams. The BOCC approved Mr. Ricker's qualifications; this did not indicate he had been appointed to the position of Inspector of Buildings / Building Commissioner only that he has the qualifications to hold that position and to complete the required exams to be certified in said position.

1/9/2013 - Reviewed Mr. Shibley's request to justify George Ricker's extension approval. Committee members did not find any supporting evidence supporting Mr. Shilbley's accusations as to who the Inspector of Buildings was for the Town of Barre in 2006 and the 'false data' as indicated in his email. Committee members feel as though the email is hearsay.

Mr. Ricker's extension request was granted on based on his appointment prior to the regulation change of R7..... and based on medical documentation provided to the Committee. Mr. Ricker is also showing due diligence in taking the required exams to be certified as an Inspector of Buildings / Building Commissioner. Committee members are aware, according to ICC rules; one cannot take the same exam more than twice in a six month period.

Committee members stated no action will be taken. Mr. Shibley may request a hearing before the BOCC if wanted. The BOCC is requesting council be present if Mr. Shibley chooses to move forward with a hearing.
