hi Felix,

I was looking over the ventilation requirements of the MA amendment

N1103.6 Mechanical Ventilation. the model code directs us to M1507 but the amendment replaces this with a formula for ventilation. the problem is that there is no amendment for section M1507 so there will be two different mechanical ventilation requirements in the 9th edition.

I recommend that you add an amendment that says the following:

M1507.3.3

Replace the first paragraph of section M1507.3.3 as follows:

"1507.3.3 the whole house mechanical ventilation system shall provide outdoor air at a continuous rate of not less than that determined in accordance with section N1103.6"

I think that will close the loop.
