PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT CONCERNING A PROPOSED HEALTHCARE PROJECT <u>Marguis Health Services, LLC</u>

Marquis Health Serives, LLC, on behalf of NE8 Operators LLC, d/b/a North End Rehabilitation & Healthcare Center, a Skilled Nursing Facility located at 70 Fulton Street, Boston, Massachusetts, Intends to file an application with the Department of Public Health for a Determination of Need ("DoN") approval to renovate its existing 140 bed facility and reduce the bed capacity to 100 beds on November 29, 2017. The reduction in beds will allow for newly created private rooms on all three floors. Also planned is a new rehabilitation gym, renovation of all resident rooms and shower/lub rooms, and renovation to all public and common areas. The estimated capital expenditure for this project is \$6,182,921 (November 2017 dollars). Any ten taxpayers of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts may register in connection with the intended application by no later than December 19, 2017 or within 20 days after the filing date for the application.
