DECISION OF THE FULL COMMISSION



The Commission's Rules of Procedure at 804 C.M.R. 1.23(1)(b)(2020) require that, in addition to a Notice of Appeal, an aggrieved party must file a Petition for Review within 30 days of receipt of the decision of the hearing officer, setting forth:

1. Issues presented for Review;
2. Statement of Facts Relevant to Issues presented for Review
3. Findings of Fact Alleged Not Supported by Substantial Evidence;
4. Alleged Errors of Law;
5. All other matters on which appellant relies to support the appeal; and

6. The relief to which the appellant believes it is entitled, which relief may be requested in the alternative.

Complainant has not filed a Petition for Review as required by 804 C.M.R 1.23. As a result of this failure to perfect her appeal in accordance with Commission regulations, Complainant's appeal is hereby dismissed and the Order of the Hearing Commissioner¹ in favor of the Respondents stands.
