DECISION

SADIQ CORPORATION DBA MASHPEE MART

Sadiq Corporation dba Mashpee Mart (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 31, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following exhibits are in evidence:

2. Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 16, 2012.

FACTS

1. On Wednesday, May 16, 2012 at approximately 07:04 p.m., Investigators Mark Kenny and Jamie Binienda conducted an investigation of the business operation of Sadiq Corporation dba Mashpee Mart.
2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a container of Bud Light beer, for six dollars and ninety-nine cents (\$6.99). The underage operative was not asked for identification.



Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**


