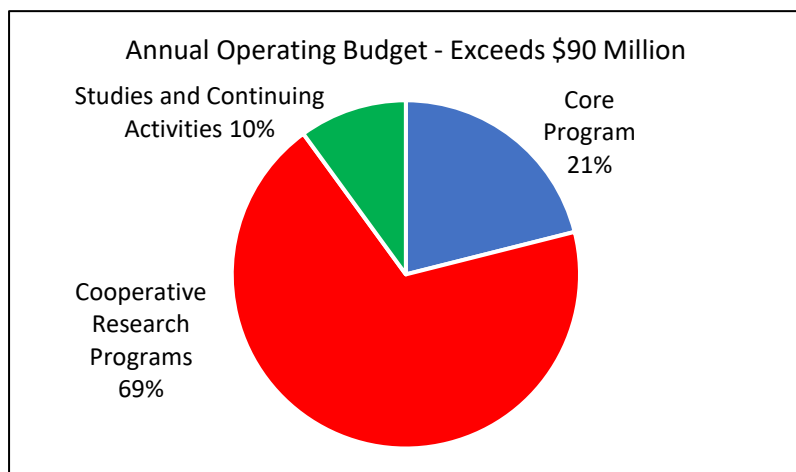


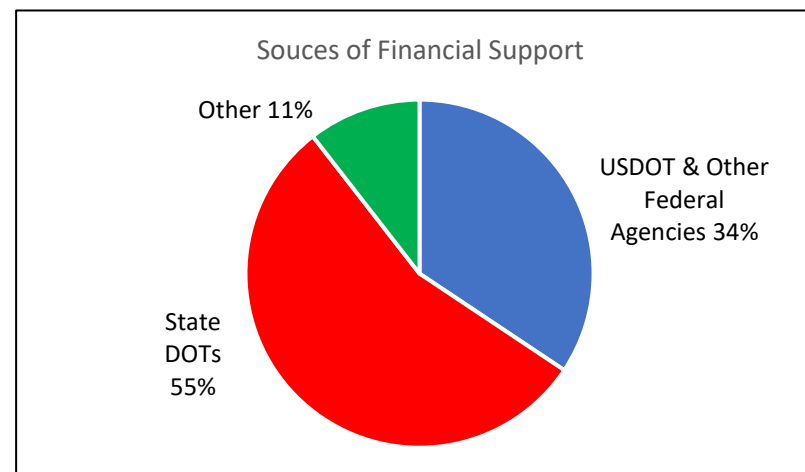
Massachusetts and TRB at a Glance

Annual Meeting, Workshops, and Webinars	The 2023 Annual Meeting hosted more than 12,200 attendees and featured more than 600 sessions with over 4,700 presentations. TRB also sponsored or co-sponsored 27 conferences and produced 98 webinars in 2023.	18 Massachusetts employees received free registration to the 2023 Annual Meeting, a value of \$23,400. 158 employees attended 67 webinars for free, a value of \$11,720 with an available 344 professional development hours.
Standing Committees and NCHRP Project Panels	The Technical Activities Division of TRB supports more than 180 Standing Committees and Councils with 4,793 members. The National Cooperative Highway Research Program (NCHRP) initiated 49 new projects in 2023 with 560 new panel members.	There are 19 Massachusetts employees currently serving on Standing Committees and 21 serving on current NCHRP Project Panels.
