Program Background

The Massachusetts Cybersecurity Program (MCP) was established in 2016 in response to the growing concern related to cybersecurity throughout the Nation. The MCP is a program within the Commonwealth Fusion Center that is focused on cybersecurity threat reporting, training, education, and awareness. The MCP aims to be an integral point of contact in the Commonwealth regarding significant cyber incidents. The MCP works closely with federal, state, local, and private sector agencies to establish effective communication and relationships.

Intelligence Products & Analysis

The MCP provides timely, concise, and relevant intelligence analysis as well as information from federal, state, local, and private sector partners. The MCP routinely distributes cybersecurity intelligence products, situational awareness messages, and other cyber-intelligence information to stakeholders. MCP intelligence products that members receive include:

- **MCP Cybersecurity Awareness Bulletins** – These bulletins highlight significant cybersecurity trends, threats, and vulnerabilities.
- **MCP Monthly Open Source Review** – These products highlight significant cybersecurity events that have occurred across key critical infrastructure sectors, with additional analysis as needed.
- **MCP Cyber Trainings** – These trainings provide timely updates related to the current cybersecurity threat landscape and cover risk mitigation measures that can help reduce the consequences of a cyberattack.
- **Federal, State, Local, and Private Sector Agency Pass-through Alerts** – The MCP is a central hub within the Commonwealth for the sharing of significant cybersecurity alerts, bulletins, and updates across multiple levels of government and key critical infrastructure sectors.
- **MA Cyber Joint Monthly Threat Briefing** - Hosted by CFC/MCP with partner agencies DHS I&A, DHS CISA, FBI, MS-ISAC, BRIC to provide monthly overview of current cyber threat landscape. Briefing is held digitally on the last Thursday of every month at 1pm.
