

Current National Emergency Grants (NEG) in Massachusetts

As of: November, 2013

Massachusetts is currently operating **12** NEG projects; total current NEG funding is **\$25,472,309** serving over **4,000** dislocated workers from **69** companies, statewide.

An employee who was laid off from any of the NEG related companies may be eligible for occupational training through any One Stop Career Center in Massachusetts.
