As of 2018, there were 320,775,014 individuals living in the community in the U.S., of which 40,678,654 were persons with disabilities; a prevalence rate of 12.7%.

State Facts

MRC serves people with disabilities in Massachusetts seeking employment, independent living and economic self-sufficiency.

As of 2018 149,633 employed 396,597 were not employed As of 2018, **6,785,622** individuals living in the community in Massachusetts, of which **803,977** were persons with disabilities; a prevalence rate of **11.8%**.

Key Services

Community Living/Independent Living Services: a variety of programs, supports, and services that address the diverse needs of adults and transition age youth with disabilities to fulfill their desire/need for community integration, to gain maximum control of their destiny, and to participate fully in their community.

Disability Determination: Handles disability claims on behalf of the Social Security Administration:

- o Determines Eligibility for Social Security Disability Insurance(SSDI)
- o Determines Eligibility for Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- o Processes Continuing Disability Review Claims (CDRs)

Vocational Rehabilitation: The federal-state vocational rehabilitation program focused on assisting individuals with disabilities to obtain, maintain, and advance in employment.
