## ACHIEVEMENTS

- Since 2004, the MSBA has made more than \$18.4 billion in payments to cities, towns and regional school districts.
- Currently, there are more than 430 projects that have received invitations from the Board of Directors to collaborate with the MSBA and are currently in the MSBA's Eligibility Period and Capital Pipeline.
- The 2025 Statement of Interest (SOI) submittal period opened on January 13, 2025. The deadline to file for consideration in the Accelerated Repair Program (ARP) was March 21, 2025, while the deadline to file for consideration in the Core Program was April 11, 2025.
- Following site visits and post-site visit due diligence, MSBA staff recommended 93 schools in 45 districts for ARP and 15 schools for the Core Program.
