MASSACHUSETTS STRATEGIC HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN & FIVE-YEAR ACTION PLAN Resources

The 2018 Massachusetts Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) is a statewide-coordinated safety plan that provides a comprehensive framework for reducing highway fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads. It identifies the State's key safety needs and guides investment decisions toward the strategies and countermeasures with the most potential to save lives and prevent injuries. Included is an overview of the plan's development, an identification of problem areas, and a 5-year action plan consisting of 61 specific strategies, 283 direct actions and 5 legislative proposals to get Massachusetts closer to our goal of zero roadway deaths. The 14 multidisciplinary emphasis areas meet to develop and implement the five-year action plan.
