Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

As you know, the above-referenced matters pertain to FirstLight Power's ongoing relicensing matters that are pending before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission under the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 797(e). In accordance with 40 CFR 121.6, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) is providing this notice to confirm that on April 22, 2024, FirstLight Power filed with MassDEP an Application for Hydroelectric Power Generation Project 401 Water Quality Certification. MassDEP has determined that the application received on April 22, 2024 meets the content requirements in 40 CFR 121.5(a)(1) and the additional content requirements identified by MassDEP in accordance with 40 CFR 121.5(c). Therefore, the one-year reasonable period of time for MassDEP to issue or deny the Water Quality Certification begins on April 22, 2024. *See* 18 CFR § 4.34(b)(5)(iii) and 18 CFR § 5.23(b)(2).
