



Amesbury - Riverwalk Connector to the Salisbury Point Ghost Trail

What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Amesbury - Riverwalk Connector to the Salisbury Point Ghost Trail project. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

Currently, there is a gap in Bicycle and Pedestrian connectivity between the end of the Amesbury Riverwalk at 100 Macy Street and the start of the Salisbury Point Ghost Trail at Elm Street. The proposed project consists of constructing a 10-foot wide paved accessible shared-use path between the end of the Amesbury-Salisbury Trail Connector project at Elm Street and the east end of the Amesbury Riverwalk at Rocky Hill Road. The connection will be approximately one-third of a mile and will traverse the back side of the Carriagetown Marketplace property at 100 Macy Rd. The project will include the construction of a shared-used path facility for bicycle and pedestrian users and will connect to the Ghost Trail via recently built bike lanes on Elm St.
