

Becket Ledge Removal along Route 8 Design Public Hearing

What is happening?

A Design Public Hearing will be held to record input on the ledge removal project on Route 8 in Becket. If not properly addressed, portions of the rock wall near Mile marker 28 may be at risk of falling onto the roadway.

How will this affect you?

The roadway will be safer to use as a result of the mitigation proposed. Rocks will be stabilized. Interruptions to traffic operations and property impacts will be minimized to the extent feasible.
