



# West Roxbury Parkway over MBTA RR Bridge Replacement Design Public Hearing

## What is happening?

The purpose of this meeting is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Arthur J. Lewis bridge (#B-16-181) replacement project (#606902) West Roxbury Parkway over the MBTA Commuter Rail located between the Holy Name Rotary and Belgrade Avenue in Boston, MA. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

## How will this affect you?

The Arthur J. Lewis bridge over the MBTA Commuter Rail has been rated in poor condition according to the last inspection report dated 7/24/2022 from MassDOT. A new, permanent bridge is therefore required to ensure the safe movement of traffic. MassDOT proposes to utilize accelerated construction methods to expedite the construction timeline. There will be a short-term detour that is implemented while West Roxbury Parkway is closed during bridge construction.
