



Virtual Design Public Hearing for Superstructure Replacement of Maffa Way and Mystic Avenue

What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the proposed Superstructure Replacement of Maffa Way & Mystic Avenue project in Boston and Somerville, MA.

How will this affect you?

MassDOT will present the project of the Superstructure Replacement of Maffa Way and Mystic Avenue over Orange Line and MBTA/BMRR. The bridge numbers are B-16-067(3GV) and B-16-027(3GW), respectively. Maffa Way will consist of a 12-foot sidewalk on the southside of the bridge with a 10-foot wide two-way bicycle lane and raised median. Mystic Avenue will consist of a 12-foot shared sidewalk on the northside of the bridge that will be shared by pedestrians and bicyclists, separated by a 1.5-foot wide visual buffer.
