

Virtual Design Public Hearing Ellis Elementary Traffic Calming

What is happening?

The purpose of this Design Public Hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the Ellis Elementary Traffic Calming Safe Routes To School Project in Boston, MA. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

Currently, the Walnut Street corridor experiences excessive travel speeds, there is a need for clarification of traffic operations at the Abbottsford Street and Crawford Street intersection, and there is an excessively long pedestrian crossing across Humboldt Avenue at Munroe Street/Humboldt Court. The construction of raised crosswalks along Walnut Street, revised geometry at Abbottsford and Crawford Streets, and a median refuge island for the pedestrian crossing across Humboldt Avenue at Munroe Street/Humboldt Court are proposed to improve safety for drivers and pedestrians.
