

Virtual Design Public Hearing Bourne Rail Trail (Phase 1) - 609262

What is happening?

The Town of Bourne and the Massachusetts Department of Transportation are hosting a Live Virtual Design Public Hearing (DPH) for the referenced project on Wednesday, September 29 at 7:00pm.

How will this affect you?

Phase 1 of Bourne Rail Trail is a proposed half-mile long paved path that will run from Monument Neck Road at John Stackpole Memorial Park from the South to the existing Cape Cod Canal Bike Path to the north. The trail will be constructed entirely within the existing railroad right of way.

A secure right-of-way is necessary for this project. Acquisitions in fee and permanent or temporary easements may be required. The town is responsible for acquiring all needed rights in private or public lands. MassDOT's policy concerning land acquisitions will be presented in the hearing.
