



Route 111 over I-495 Bridge Replacement Virtual Design Public Hearing

What is happening?

A virtual Design Public Hearing will be held to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed **replacement of the bridge carrying Route 111 (Massachusetts Avenue) over I-495 in Boxborough, MA**. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The deteriorated bridge has reached 60 years of service life, provides a substandard vertical clearance, and carries no pedestrian or bicycle accommodations. The bridge will be demolished and replaced with a new bridge designed for a 75 year service life with an improved vertical clearance, as well as future accommodations for pedestrians and bicyclists that will improve mobility for all users throughout the area. Traffic will be maintained throughout the project during all stages of construction.
