Replacement of the Grove Street over Salisbury Plain River Bridge & Intersection Improvements at Grove/Summer/Lyman Streets in Brockton, MA

What is happening?

The purpose of this Virtual Design Public Hearing is to present the proposed reconstruction of the Lyman/Summer/Grove Streets intersection and the replacement of the Grove Street bridge over the Salisbury Plain River in Brockton, MA. This project will enhance roadway safety through new traffic and pedestrian signals, ADA-compliant sidewalks and ramps, bicycle accommodations, updated signage and pavement markings, and relocation of overhead utilities. The project will bring the Grove Street bridge up to safe AASHTO load capacity standards and upgraded stormwater capacity beneath the new bridge.

How will this affect you?

The project is designed to make the roads safer for everyone, improve traffic flow, and create better access for people walking or using bicycles. During construction of the new bridge, Grove Street will be closed at the Summer Street and Lyman Street intersection with a detour in place. Access to residences will be maintained during construction. Work at the intersection will also involve temporary lane closures and may include short-term detours.
