Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements on Route 123

Brockton, MA and Abington, MA

What is happening?

A design public hearing is being held to share information regarding the provision and improvement of sidewalks and buffered on-street bicycle lanes along a 2.3-mile-long segment of Route 123. The project extends from Cary Street/Lyman Street in Brockton, and to Ashland Street in Abington.

How will this affect you?

Once completed, the safety of walking and bicycling along Route 123 will be enhanced. All sidewalks and curb ramps will be accessible to pedestrians. The existing signalized intersection at Route 123 and Quincy Street in Brockton will be upgraded.
