Brookline – Improvements at William H. Lincoln School (SRTS)

What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Improvements associated with William H. Lincoln School Safe Routes to School project. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed Safe Routes to School project will formalize the roadway cross section of the town implemented pilot program along Kennard Road, including pedestrian, bicycle, and traffic control upgrades. Kennard Road will operate one-way northbound between Walnut Street and Route 9 with a 10-foot travel lane and an 8-foot parking lane. A separated, southbound contraflow bicycle lane (approximately 5 feet wide) will be provided with a painted buffer and flexible delineator posts. Sidewalks and ADA-compliant curb ramps will be reconstructed on both sides to provide a minimum 5-foot clear path of travel, where feasible.
