

Upper North Street Reconstruction Buckland, MA

What is happening?

The proposed project consists of the reconstruction of approximately 0.5 miles of North Street, beginning from 85 North Street and traveling north to the intersection with Ashfield Road (MA Route 112). The proposed improvements include the addition of a 5.5-foot concrete sidewalk and curb on the west side of the road, full depth road reconstruction, replacement of substandard guardrails, and drainage improvements including enhancement of water quality. The purpose of this meeting is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Upper North Street Reconstruction project. All views and comments submitted in response to the meeting will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible. How will this affect you?

The roadway reconstruction and the addition of the sidewalk will improve safety and provide connectivity for all roadway users and pedestrians. Traffic will be maintained throughout construction as well as access to all properties. Attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions and offer comments. When
