



# Chelmsford - Public Information Meeting for replacement of two bridges

## What is happening?

A Live Virtual Public Information Meeting will be hosted on the MassDOT website to present an overview of the forthcoming project to replace two bridges carrying Gorham St over I495 and Westford St over I495.

## How will this affect you?

The proposed design for Gorham St will have two travel lanes (one in each direction), shoulders/bike lanes with buffers and sidewalks on both sides. The proposed design for Westford St will have two travel lanes (one in each direction), shoulders/bike lanes and sidewalks on both sides. One way traffic will be maintained through construction. The opposite direction traffic will be detoured.
