What is happening?

A design public hearing will be held for the Streiber Memorial School Safe Routes To School Project in the City of Chicopee. The project proposes to construct new and replace existing sidewalks and install crosswalks along portions of Telegraph Avenue, Streiber Drive, and Irene Court and in front of the Chicopee Housing Authority and the school itself to facilitate safe walking to and from school.

How will this affect you?

These infrastructure improvements will allow students to walk to and from school safely. The project includes both construction of new sidewalks and replacement of existing sidewalks.
