



Public Information Meeting Bardwell's Ferry Bridge Conway/Shelburne, MA

What is happening?

The purpose of this project is to re-open the bridge by replacing severely deteriorated weathering-steel beams in the short Conway approach span with new steel beams that have a redundant, long-lasting, corrosion-protection system of hot-dip galvanizing and painting. To help preserve the bridge for future generations, the wood floor system will be replaced and the existing steel and wrought iron components to remain will be cleaned and painted. About 100 ft of each roadway approaching the bridge will be milled and paved, along with drainage adjustments and guardrail improvements.

How will this affect you?

The bridge is currently closed, and traffic is detoured. This existing detour will remain in place for the duration of the proposed construction. Other than occasional construction traffic traveling to and from the bridge, the project should have no significant impacts on the public during construction.
