

Route 28 over Bass River Bridge Replacement and Intersection Improvements at Main Street (Route 28)/ North Main Street/ Old Main Street Virtual Design Public Hearing

What is happening?

MassDOT is proposing to replace the Bass River Bridge, which carries Route 28 over the Bass River between the towns of Dennis and Yarmouth and make improvements to the intersection of Main Street (Route 28) at North Main Street and Old Main Street, in Yarmouth. Work is anticipated to begin in 2023. The purpose of this upcoming meeting is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the project.

How will this affect you?

During the design public hearing, MassDOT will review the construction activities, schedule, and community impacts. Attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions and offer comments.
