What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed District 5: Bridge Bundle Design-Build project for the preservation of the George Street over Copeland Drive Bridge in Mansfield, Pickens Street over Route 140 Bridge in Lakeville, and the Charge Pond Road over Route 25 Bridge in Wareham. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The current bridges are slated to be repaired with updated sidewalks and safety barriers. The proposed project will utilize detours and staged construction at each location. For bridges that are staged construction, vehicular and pedestrian accommodations will be provided.
