



Virtual Design Public Hearing Vulnerable Road User Missing Crosswalks at State Signals at Multiple Locations in MassDOT Districts 2, 3, 4, & 5

What is happening?

A virtual design public hearing is being held to share information regarding upgrades to existing pedestrian signal features and installation of additional crosswalks to facilitate safe pedestrian crossings at seven locations across Massachusetts in MassDOT Districts 2, 3, 4, and 5. These sites are located in Chicopee, Worcester, Billerica, Salem, Woburn, North Attleborough, and Falmouth.

How will this affect you?

These upgrades will make it safer to cross the street at the locations included in the project. This is particularly helpful for people using the bus system. A disproportionate number of crashes involving pedestrians have historically occurred near bus stops.
